Floorservice Prime Weathered Grey has been developed to create that typical aged and greyish effect on oak wood. The possibilities are countless and this, combined with a top coat of either colour within our range of Floorservice Hardwax-oil Classic, Pro or Profiline, leads to various creative and commercially interesting colour options.

Characteristics

Floorservice Prime Weathered Grey is a pre-treatment product for aging wood.

Application

On raw untreated tannin-containing wooden objects of oak or larch.

Technical information

Surface: Has to be dry, clean and free of grease.

Processing temperature: 15 – 35c at 65% relative humidity.

Drying time: At 20°C and 65% RH Depending on ventilation: min. 6 HRS.

After drying de-nib the surface by using a Bordeaux pad (remove fibres and salts).

Do not use pad for more than approx.. 40sqm (using both sides).

Usage: 4-8sqm / litre, heavily depending on application method and surface.

Cleaning of tools: with water.

Storage: Frost free storage!

Density (20°C): 1,00 – 1,02 kg/L method: DIN 53217

Flashpoint: Non-flammable.

Packing: 20 Litres

Shelf life: 6 Months

Application advise

Apply Floorservice Prime Weathered Grey evenly by nebulizing onto the surface. After 30 seconds of contact, equalize the moisturized parts with a non-linting cloth or mop. NOTE!: By overlapping, using too little product or spilling droplets onto the wood, uneven discoloration is possible.
